POULTRY FARMING

Smt. Usha Danappanavar has approached KVK during the year 1996 and undergone on campus training in poultry production at KVK, Hanumanamatti. Subsequently she has approached the Canara Bank, Ranebennur for financial basis. She has constructed one layer house, one brooder cum layer house. Initially started with 6000 birds presently they are having 11000 birds at the farm. An average of 5000 eggs per day and selling them at the rate of Rs.1.25 and a total income of Rs. 5000/- per day, since 8 months. 60% of this money will go for loan repayment and recurring expenditure. Initially she used to get feed from private factories, presently she has started feed mixing unit. With the guidance of the KVK scientists they are preparing the feed at the farm, with this the expenditure reduced by 15%. Smt. Usha is active and participate in exhibitions, kisan melas, field days and seminars as and when they are conducted. She is having scientific approach and easily adopt new technologies that are developed at University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad.
